INTRODUCTION

Welcome to Cramlington/Town Football Club

Thank you for choosing to join and play for Cramlington Town Football Club this season. Cramlington Town is a voluntary run football club that provides teams for boys, girls at a junior level and men's and women's senior teams, including a participation team.

We are based in Cramlington but have players from surrounding towns and villages.

The club prides itself on providing all children no matter their ability, a safe and secure environment to learn how to play football whilst having fun.

Coaches

All coaches meet the criteria set out by the National FA. This includes a current CRC certificate that is updated every 3 years.

Registering your child to the club

- A £10.00 membership fee
- A passport quality size photo (No more than 3 months old). This can be taken on your phone
 and sent to the club secretary along with your child's full name and team name.
- A fully completed club membership form
- A fully completed standing order form
- A fully completed league registration form
- Proof of your child's age

The club will hold two days over a weekend for your to attend and sign your child to the club.

Subscriptions

The annual club subscription is £220.00. This is payable over 10 months (August – May). A sibling discount is available, as is the opportunity to pay a one off fee.

Club ties

All players must own a club tie to attend league and club presentations. If your child does not already own one, the cost is £7.00.

Training and matches

The club train and play their home games at Cramlington Sporting Club. U7 and U8 teams play their games at a central venue organised by the PPRFL.

Teams train once a week on grass from April to September, however teams may decide to train more often.

Through the winter months October to March, teams train once a week on the 3G.

League matches are predominately played at the weekend, however at the start of the season and towards the end of it, midweek fixtures may occur.

Fundraising

Each team is able to raise funds for its own team, with the club receiving 10% of what is raised. This does not apply to small fund raisers such as pitch side raffles. The club organises at least one club event that all teams are expected to participate in. All money raised is reinvested back into the club.
